Nowadays, when she's not scrapbooking or competing in epicurean competitions with family members, you can find her jotting down story ideas or writing poetry.

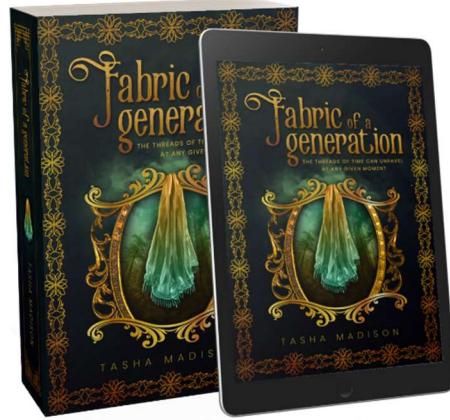

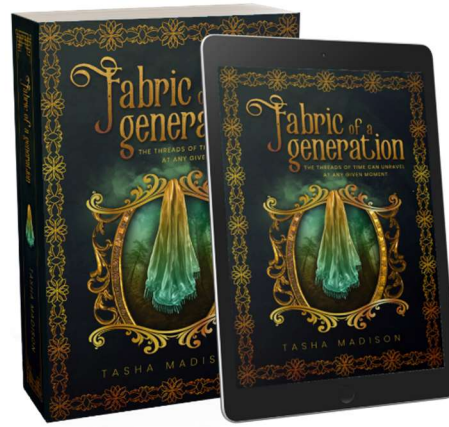
